Introduction

In the memory of those public health professionals in Newfoundland and Labrador who have contributed significantly to the growth of public health, and specifically the field of environmental health, in the province the Newfoundland and Labrador Branch of the Canadian Institute of Health Inspectors has established the **Memorial Award**.

The Memorial Award will be awarded bi-annually to an individual in Newfoundland and Labrador who has contributed significantly to the field of Environmental/Public Health in the preceding twenty-four month period (July 01, 20XX to June 30, 20XX +2).

Nominations:

Individuals must be nominated by a member in good standing with the Newfoundland and Labrador Branch of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors.

Nominations in the format determined by the Award Selection Committee (ASC), will be accepted by the ASC up to September 30 of the year the award is to be presented. The first deadline for nominations is September 30, 2006. Subsequent deadlines will be September 30 every two years thereafter.

Eligibility:

The Memorial Award may be awarded to individuals who have made an outstanding or significant contribution to public health in Newfoundland and Labrador. Priority consideration will be given to nominees who have demonstrated leadership in dealing with a critical issue affecting environmental health or public health. Nominees can be private citizens, educators, researchers, public servants (provincial, federal or municipal), employees of non-governmental organization or employees of private industry.

The Award:

The recipient of the award will receive an individual award to recognize his/her achievement. As well, the recipients name will be engraved on a Memorial Award wall plaque which will be displayed at NL Branch events. Sample awards are displayed below.
